Your Fighting Indians Volleyball team had another dominating performance at home last night by defeating Lincoln Park Academy 25-16, 25-18, 25-11. Both the Varsity and JV teams are 3-0 to start the season. You can catch all of the action next Tuesday when they host a very tough Okeechobee squad. JV begins at 5:30 with the varsity match to follow.

United Soccer Coaches annually celebrates the academic achievements of high school soccer teams whose student-athletes collectively demonstrate a commitment to excellence in their studies over the course of a full academic year. A total of 315 soccer teams (127 boys, 196 girls) throughout the United States have earned the United Soccer Coaches High School Team Academic Award for exemplary performance in the classroom as a team during the 2022-23 academic year. Among these programs were 38 schools receiving honors for both their boys' and girls' teams. Vero Beach High School was among the 38 to have both the girls and boys program receive such a team academic award. To qualify for the award, the team must have a minimum grade point average of 3.25 for the entire academic year.
