Your football team improved to 2-0 with a 26-11 win over #9 Ranked Palm Beach Gardens last night at the Citrus Bowl. The Offense racked up 495 yards of total offense and were led by Senior Quarterback Tyler Aronson. Aronson finished the night 24 of 34 passing for 302 yards. Sophomore Running Back Jonathan Hillsman had another big night with over 200 yards of total offense. Hillsman had 14 Carries for 131 yards and 1 Touchdown. Senior Receiver Isaiah Roberts had a big night with 8 Receptions for 112 yards and 1 Touchdown. Sophomore Jarvis Jacobs added a 21 yard Touchdown Reception.

The Defense was equally impressive as Junior Linebacker TJ Alford was dominant and led the team in tackles. Seniors Tutu Griffin, Amar Reynolds, and Elijah Anderson all had big nights. The Football team will be back in action next Friday night, September 15<sup>th</sup>, vs Fort Pierce Westwood. Kick Off will be at 7pm at the Citrus Bowl.
