Today we observe National Constitution Day, on September 17th 1787 the delegates to the Constitutional Convention met for the last time to sign the document they had created.

With its preamble:

We the People of the United States, in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America.

The Football team improved to 3-0 on Friday night with a dominant 35-0 win over previously undefeated Fort Pierce Westwood. Senior Quarterback Tyler Aronson completed 11 of 12 passes for 153 yards and 4 Touchdowns. Sophomore Running Back Jonathan Hillsman had 133 total yards of offense, as he finished the night with 7 carries for 71 yards, 3 receptions for 62 yards and 2 Touchdowns. EJ White, Isaiah Roberts, and Tutu Griffin all added touchdowns. The Defense was dominant in the Shutout and held the Panthers to 104 yards of total offense. Anthwone Montgomery was a force all night with 5 Tackles, 3 ½ Tackles for Loss, and 1 Sack. Aidan Smith and Donquaill Wesley each had interceptions. And Tutu Griffin blocked a Field Goal.

The team will be back in action this Friday night at the Citrus Bowl as we take on State Ranked Seminole High School. Student tickets will be on sale during lunch starting on Wednesday.
