Homecoming Weekend got off to a great start on Friday night as the Football Team improved to 7-1 Overall and 3-0 in the District with a 28-3 win over Martin County High School. The Defense led the way with 4 Interceptions, including "2" by Senior Elijah Anderson (1 returned for a Touchdown). Another by Junior RJ Jones, and one by Junior TJ Alford. Alford led the defense with 16 total tackles including 1 tackle for loss. Seniors Kevin Pollock and Matthew Bacon each had 10 tackles. Sophomore Running Back Jonathan Hillsman was again outstanding with over 100 yards of total offense, including a 23-yard touchdown run. Senior Quarterback Tyler Aronson completed 17 of 31 passes for 179 yards and 1 Touchdown. Senior Receiver Isaiah Roberts had 3 catches for 70 yards and 1 touchdown and Senior Running Back Octavion Osby added a Rushing Touchdown. The Football Team is on the road this week as it travels to Treasure Coast High School on Saturday for a 7pm Kick Off.
