Sage Morrow was the individual regional Champ! Our girls' cross country team finished in 6th place, so both cross country teams are headed to Tallahassee for the state championship meet on Friday! Henry Hazell placed 17<sup>th</sup> at the FHSAA Swimming State Championship in Ocala on Friday, way to go Henry!

Your Fighting Indian Girls' Golf Team placed 8<sup>th</sup> in the FHSAA Golf State Championship.

The Football Team went on the road for their victory in the first round of the State Playoffs on Friday night traveling to Palm Bay and defeated Heritage High School by the score of 28-17. Senior Running Back Octavion Osby led the way on offense with 123 yards on 17 carries, scoring 3 Touchdowns. Senior Quarterback Tyler Aronson completed 12 of 16 passes for 204 yards and 1 touchdown. Senior Receiver Isaiah Roberts had 4 receptions for 97 yards. Junior Running Back Josh Lancifort added a 30 yard Touchdown Reception. Kicker Braydon Marson was 4 for 4 on Extra Points. The Defense was once again outstanding, holding Heritage to 20 points less than their average points per game. The team would like to thank all of those who made the trip, especially the Band and Cheerleaders! The 12<sup>th</sup> man was rocking! With the victory, the team advances to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of the State Playoffs this Friday night in a Rematch vs Treasure Coast High School at South County Stadium in Port St. Lucie.
