The boys basketball program got off to a good start, as both JV and Varsity teams won by 25 and 26 points vs Tradition Prep last Tuesday. The varsity team recorded a 77-51 win as the team had 4 players score in double figures. Jeremiah Sanders filled the stat sheet up as he posted 7 points, 9 assist, 5 steals and 5 rebounds with 1 blocked shot. Isaiah Martinez had a team high 14 points with 5 steals and 4 rebounds. Will Holderman and Jayden Peart each scored 13 points.

On the Friday and Saturday before we left for break, VBHS hosted the District 15 Thespian One Act Festival and our very own Thespian Troupe 2047 earned the following awards: All-Star Cast Member went to Jessah Moore as the best in our one act. December 4-8th Freshmen and Sophomores will be FAST testing which is the reading test that must be passed for graduation and it's an adaptive test in 3 progress monitoring parts PM1, 2, and 3. You took PM1 at the start of the school year, PM2 is in the beginning of December, and PM3 is in the spring. Adaptive means that growth is measured between each test, and PM2 is the beginning of PM3 which means that PM3 picks up where you left off on PM2. We are incentivizing PM2 for testing students who show growth will be invited to a field day Field Day on December 19th for their growth in FAST PM 1 to PM2.
