Girls basketball hosted Harmony High school last Friday night. JV winning 51-7. Jasmine Bryant scored 12 points. Shayla Baisley and Shamyia Jennings scoring 8 points and Jeanne Perry added 6 points. Varsity final score was 62-31. Davionne Stinson & Ekklesia Anderson both scored 15 points and Aubriyonna Felder adding 13 points. Girls next game is Wednesday at LPA.

Our Lady Indian wrestling team had another successful outing, as they traveled to the west coast for one of the toughest girl's tournaments in the state. Our ladies finished an impressive 6th place out of 18 teams running a little short with only 8 girls competing. Our 4 medalists were: Brenda Gomez, Jayla Benjamin, Kelis Tawzer, and Mya Wallace. This week, December 4-8th Freshmen and Sophomores will be FAST testing which is the reading test that Sophomores must pass for graduation. FAST is an adaptive test in 3 progress monitoring parts PM1, PM2, and PM3. You took PM1 at the start of the school year in August, PM2 is this week, and PM3 is in the spring. Adaptive means that growth is measured between each of the 3 tests. This means that PM2 is actually the beginning of PM3 so doing well this week means your test may be easier in the spring. Also, we are incentivizing PM2 for testing students who show a level of growth from PM1 in August to PM2 this week, with a field day Field Day on December 19th by invitation only.

The Treasure Coast Technical College will be adding a new program to start in January, Baking and Pastry. This course is open to seniors and will begin on January 10 and run through May 17. Students will learn baking and pastry skills and earn a certificate in baking and pastry as well as the SafeServ Manager certification. Students can see their counselor if they are interested.
