Vero Beach Unified Flag Football team won their third consecutive FHSAA state championship yesterday at the University of Central Florida. Vero won the semifinal game 38-7 vs New Smyrna Beach. In the state championship game Vero held a 5-point lead at the half against Mt Dora. The defense readjusted and had a shutout in the second half to win 51-20. Tirell Baskin threw for 225 yards and 7 touchdowns on the day. Jackson Rahal threw for 125 yards and 2 touchdowns. Rahal also had three receiving touchdowns and two interceptions. David Mendez ran for 99 yards and had two tackles. Kevin Pollock play lights out defense and had 120 yards receiving. Wyatt Scruggs recorded 105 yards receiving with four touchdowns, Scruggs also had 8 tackles and one interception. Jamerious King recorded ten tackles and three touchdowns. Noah Molina rushed for 75 yards and had four catches. Lawrence Herbert had 175 yards receiving with three touchdowns and 6 tackles. This was the 11th state championship in program history. The Girls Weightlifting team traveled to Harmony HS last night and defeated four teams St. Cloud, Harmony, Celebration, and Gateway in the Olympic and Traditional meets. First place finishers for Vero Beach were Cayle Bihl, Devoney Villanueva, Carol Martinez, Enyjai Tyson, Jada Mosley, Joey Rose Castle, and Ava Sesack. Next meet will be at home next Wednesday in the small gym.

This week Freshmen and Sophomores will be FAST testing which is the reading test that Sophomores must pass for graduation. FAST is an adaptive test in 3 progress monitoring parts PM1, PM2, and PM3. You took PM1 at the start of the school year in August, PM2 is this week, and PM3 is in the spring. Adaptive means that growth is measured between each of the 3 tests. This means that PM2 is actually the beginning of PM3 so doing well this week means your test may be easier in the spring. Also, we are incentivizing PM2 for testing students who show a level of growth from PM1 in August to PM2 this week, with a field day Field Day on December 19th by invitation only.
