Students, you must be in class to learn. This is a clarification for you regarding restroom passes. The time you have for a bathroom pass is 5 minutes from the time that is written on the pass.

Remember also, simplify your experience entering school.

Remember: arrive a few minutes earlier than you normally do, 7:00 at the latest. The tardy policy remains in effect so plan accordingly. You must be in the checkpoint line by 7:00 (first bell) in order to get a security pass to class. Also it is your responsibility to take the pass as they are passed out at the gate. If you forget to take the pass at the gate, then you will need to go to the cafeteria for a pass.
