Students, you must be in class to learn. This is a clarification for you regarding restroom passes. The time you have for a bathroom pass is 5 minutes from the time that is written on the pass.

Remember: arrive a few minutes earlier than you normally do, 7:00 at the latest. The tardy policy remains in effect so plan accordingly. You must be in the checkpoint line by 7:00 (first bell) in order to get a security pass to class. Security passes will expire at 7:15am.
